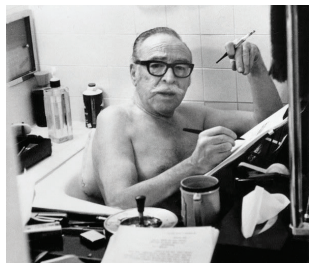


A MAN VANISHES (1967)
